GARBAGE

We have no garbage collection so please take your garbage back to town with you.

DOGS

Dogs must be on a leash and please pick up after your dog.

SPEED LIMIT

The speed limit on Protection Island is 20 km/hr.

GOLF CART REGULATIONS

Drivers must hold a valid driver's license and drive responsibly.

The number of passengers is restricted to the number of seats the golf cart was equipped with by the original manufacturer.

Golf carts must be registered, insured, licensed, and equipped as specified in the accompanying British Columbia Ministry of Transportation and Highways document entitled
Golf Cart Use On a Public Road

Golf Cart Use On a Public Road

Use of golf carts on public roads is permitted only under the following strict conditions:

- 1. For incidental use crossing from one part of a golf course to another part of the same course; or**
- 2. on an island not accessible by scheduled vehicle ferry service or bridge;**
 - where posted speed limit is no greater than 20 kilometres per hour;**
 - golf cart must be registered, insured and licensed; and**
 - equipped with specific safety features, (i.e., horn, rear view mirror, head and tail lamps, turn signals and reflectors).**

Police will continue to enforce regulations governing the use of golf carts and ticket anyone who fails to meet all safety requirements.
